INSPECTION: All dogs will be inspected for soundness & measured prior to running each event. All bitches will be checked for being in-season prior to running each event.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined as an event number). Dogs registering with AKC as Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered and are subject to a separate registration fee of \$19.00 paid to AKC. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Daneen Fox at Daneenfox@aol.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

HOW DOES FAST CAT WORK

TESTS, TITLES & TIMING

Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards. Dogs run singularly. The dog is released at the starting line by one person and must be caught by a second person at the finish line. "Handlers are not permitted to run down the 100-yard course with a dog during its run. If the course is fenced, this includes both inside or outside the fence. Handlers shall simply release the dog in the starting box and may not run with the dog within the starting box. Handlers may run within the catchment area as their dog is running the course but may not cross the finish line. Cheering, clapping, calling your dog's name, whistling and waving your arms from the end of the course or the start area is allowed. Noise making devices such as whistles, duck calls, electronic calls or other items of this nature are not permitted. The use of toys, treats, flags or other items of this nature are not permitted while the dog is running the 100-yard course, however they may be used after the dog has crossed the finish line to assist in catching the dog." (Section 14. Conduct of Handlers). The time to complete the 100 yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second (e.g. 9.11). The club uses break-the-beam equipment to obtain the time. The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into mph. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap.

The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at the withers:

18" or greater = handicap is 1.0

12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5

Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

FAST CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = each additional 500 points

GENERAL RULES

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
2. Each entry will be examined and may be measured with a wicket at inspection. AKC Height cards accepted. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete, or a female in season, shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded. The decision of the Field Committee is final.
3. Dogs should be warmed up and cooled down before/after runs. Field Committee will decide minimum rest period between concurrent Event runs and may change without notice as conditions warrant.
4. All AKC rules of sportsmanship and conduct shall apply

5. This is a rain or shine event. Bring whatever you need to keep you and your dog comfortable.
6. Muzzles are allowed. Dogs may wear any type of collar except no choker, prong or electronic training collars. The club recommends using a plain collar and lead, and we discourage the use of flexi leads for safety reasons. Hanging tags should be taped or rubber banded or removed. Hair may be banded or clipped. Head halters permitted on grounds but not while running the course.
7. Electric continuous loop machines will be used. Lures consist of white plastic. Course is fenced. Property perimeter is partially fenced.
8. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
9. There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress (per AKC). The following actions may result in a fine and/or being excused from the event: exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct, not picking up after one's dog, or littering in any area of the event.
10. NO ONE is allowed on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman, except the appointed Field Committee.
11. There is NO SMOKING anywhere on the grounds. You can smoke in your car. Please be respectful of others.
12. No entry fees shall be refunded in the event that the trials are cancelled due to acts of God, including but not limited to fires, war, riots.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space :There is a dirt parking lot. Bring your own shade and water.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

GLASWC will provide sodas and water and food will be available for purchase.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

GLASWC will offer light blue flat ribbon for successful pass of test.

GLASWC will offer 1-4 place rosettes for

- Fastest under 12"
- Fastest 12" to 18"
- Fastest 18" or greater

GLASWC will offer a "New Title" rosette for any dog finishing a BCAT, DCAT or FCAT title.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all tests safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times. Prong, choke, electronic collars and retractable leashes may not be used when on coursing test grounds.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the event(s) cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Field Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
