Trials are pre-entry. Day of Show (DOS) entries will be allowed on a first come, first serve basis up to limit of 120 runs per judge per trial. Enter early to secure your spot!

Pre-entry final closing date is Jan. 18, 2023

(Entries postmarked after the closing date are considered DOS entries) Additional Classes added DOS for a dog/s that were entered and paid pre-entry prices will be at the pre entry price.

There will be two trials each day running simultaneously. Trial A classes will run then trial B classes will run. Running order will be posted at the trial site and will be adjusted if conflicts should occur. Move ups are allowed.

Dogs must be older than 6 months and registered with the Barn Hunt Association to enter trial. Please go to www.barnhunt.com to register.

Awards

Ribbons are awarded for first through fourth place in each of the three height divisions for Novice through Masters. First place prizes will also be given. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each person who qualifies. RATI qualifiers will get qualifying ribbons only. Ribbons will also be awarded for teams attaining a new RATN, RATO, RATS or RATM title! Rosettes also awarded for high in trial!

Assumption of Risk

Owners or handlers entering dogs in a trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for damage caused by them, or by their dogs and hold the trial club and Barn Hunt Association harmless for any injury sustained by their dog or by a person during the trial . By entering a trial, owners attest that they have read, understand, and will abide by, all Barn Hunt rules

Cancellation Policy

Every attempt will be made to hold a Barn Hunt Association, LLC event as scheduled. In the event of an "Act of God" such as fire, flood, etc. an event may be canceled. In such an event, entry fees will not be refunded. Entries will be refunded for injured dogs with veterinary documentation.

Loud/Disruptive dogs

Dogs that are loud and disruptive may be asked to locate away from the rings/crating area and/or staged away from the other dogs getting ready to compete.

Bitches in season policy

Bitches in season (BIS) MAY compete in barn hunt trials. They will run at the end of each class and be staged separate from other dogs. They must wear pants/britches at all times when not being pottied including on course. Owners of BIS must crate/confine their dogs away from traffic and other dogs and should post “dog in season” signs on their crate/in their area, and potty the dog away from other competitors. Owners of BIS must make their condition known to trial secretary prior to arrival if possible or upon arrival if prior notice is not possible. They should also make condition known at trial briefing. Failure to notify the club and competitors of a BIS will result in a disqualification and dismissal from show grounds.

Aggression

Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or person may be dismissed from the trial if justification is found to do so by the judge or trial committee. Any dog approaching the judge in a threatening manner inside the ring may be dismissed on the judge’s discretion. All dogs are expected to be able to work within the closed area with a judge and a rat wrangler in close proximity. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Collars and Leashes

Electronic collars and devices are not allowed on trial grounds. Head halters are not allowed on trial grounds. At no time should dogs be tied out or otherwise left attached to something other than a human. Dogs may not be brought to the line in any disallowed collar. Dogs may not be brought to the line on flexi-leads. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dogs MUST run “naked,” without a collar/harness. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses that can be quickly removed and replaced.

Elimination on Course

Elimination on the course is an NQ (non-qualifying) score for the dog, and the dog must be immediately removed from the course and is not allowed to continue. Elimination includes urination, defecation, and/or spitting up/throwing up. Belly bands are not allowed. If a Bitch in Season squats in the ring with the clear motion of peeing, she is to be NQ and removed even with pants on.

Cleaning up after dogs

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
