Awards

Each dog passing Fast CAT will be offered a light blue qualifying ribbon. Dog must cross the start line and the finish line on its own. Dogs earning titles will be offered Rosettes.

Events offered and Other Important Information

NO BITCHES IN SEASON MAY RUN. ALL DOGS MUST RUN ON LIMITED SLIP OR FLAT COLLAR. NO CHOKE, PINCH COLLARS ALLOWED. TAGS SHOULD BE REMOVED OR TAPED FLAT TO COLLARS.

Fast CAT: Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and spayed neutered dogs are eligible to participate. A dog may enter only once per event—defined by an event number.

The Event Committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter the track as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the event.

AKC Section 3.2 Bitches in season, or bitches which come in season after the close of entries, shall be barred from participating in the event or trial and their entry fees refunded. Notification to the Field Secretary of bitches in season must be made before or during the roll call. Bitches known to be in season shall not be brought onto the trial grounds.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, loss of site, extreme weather conditions, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

Two separate events are being offered each day and will run **concurrently.** You may use one entry form per dog to enter one or all events by circling the information on the entry form. Each event requires a \$25 entry feefor pre-entered dogs. Late entries and day of entries \$30. Conditional entries will not be accepted.

Entry forms may be completed online at www.socalscentwork.com (look under the Sprint Trials tab). After completing the online entry, payment should be made through Zelle to daneenfox@aol.com. In the notes, please put your last name, the dog's call name, and the date of the event. Or, print the form and mail it with a check made payable to: Daneen Fox, P.O. BOX 552, ACTON, CA 93510-0552.

We are no longer using PayPal because of the extra fees. Please use Zelle, as indicated above, or send payment by check via mail.

You must provide two leashes for your dog; one to hold your dog and one to catch your dog. Please arrange for someone to either release or catch your dog, since you cannot be in two different places 100 yards apart. There will be dog holders/releasers, known as slippers at the staging area. Be sure your dog can be caught at the end of the course. Exhibitors should be familiar with all AKC Fast CAT rules prior to running. The Event Chairperson will have a complete copy of the rules available at the event site. Toys and treats may be in the catch area, out of sight, until the dog crosses the line.

Trial Hours: 8:00am until 4:00pm. Actual start time will be determined at a later time.

Inspection and check-in will run at the beginning of each time slot. The two events will be run concurrently. The link to sign up for a time slot to run, for each day, will be sent via email to each competitor with the confirmation after the entry is processed and payment is received. Please arrive during your time that you signed up for. You will have plenty of time to run your dog(s) in that time frame. All dogs will be inspected prior to their run as required by AKC.

We are offering the flexibility for you to choose when to run your dog. Concurrent means you can run both runs in the morning, both in the afternoon. or one in the AM and one in the PM. We hope this reduces your stress level because we want you to have **FUN!!!!** Invite your friends!
